Operating licence extended to September 2022

Last month, The Department of Water and Environmental Regulation (DWER) issued a six-month extension to Cockburn Cement Limited's (CCL) operating licence at our Munster site. This news follows a nine-month licence extension issued in May last year.

This licence extension will allow us to continue our operations which contribute more than \$500 million directly to the WA economy each year and to meet the growing demand for our products as a result of the booming state infrastructure developments and projects.

Our team is committed to innovation and the continuous improvement of our operations. We are also dedicated to reducing the impact on the local community. The extension allows us more time to work with DWER to trial odour reduction solutions on Kiln 6.

Land use at our Munster site

Adbri (Cockburn Cement's parent company) has undertaken national reviews of its land holdings with the objective to actively manage these to better reflect our current and future operational needs.

From these reviews, we have identified unused land that is surplus to our operational needs at our Munster operations. This land has been zoned for light industrial use under the Latitude32 Industry Zone Plan. You can read more about the DevelopmentWA project through the below link.



We will keep you informed as we continue investigations on the potential use of Munster sites surplus land.

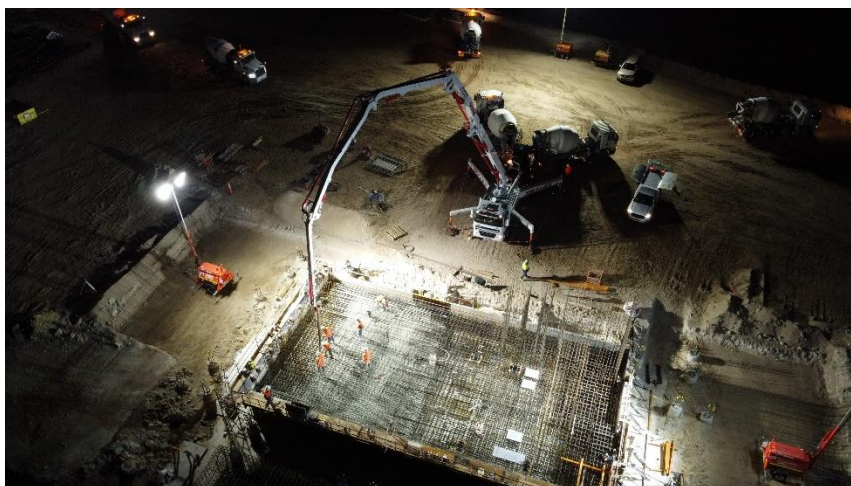
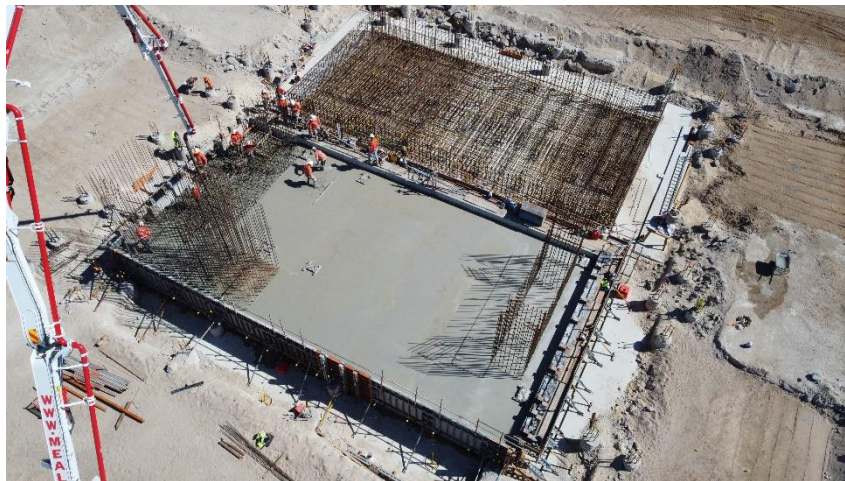

Kwinana Upgrade Project Update

Works on the \$199 million Kwinana Upgrade Project are progressing well with its first major concrete pour achieved last month. An early start saw **436 cubic metres** of concrete poured by 10.30am. The pour is the foundation for one of the new mills and yes, 100% Cockburn Cement was used. Great effort by the team, including our subcontractors Melchor and WA Pre-Mix.

The Project will combine Munster and Kwinana cement operations to create a single facility at our Kwinana site that will increase the annual production in Western Australia from 1.1 million tonnes to 1.5 million tonnes per annum. The project is expected to be completed in mid-2023 and we will continue to bring you updates as works progress.
